Thank you for visiting sgaa.me. Our recreational league offers lots of sports and we need volunteers!

For most sports, there is no set schedule for specific age groups on one particular night of the week. Games begin at 6 pm on weeknights and at 9 am on Saturdays. Except for football and cheer, on weeknights, two games are usually played back to back on the same field or court for each league that is scheduled. For most sports, we try not to schedule games on Sundays unless we’ve had a lot of rainouts.

Please note that refunds are NOT given after teams are drafted, except for football, which allows refunds within the first 2 weeks after the first scheduled practice for the league. Cheerleaders will not receive refunds after uniforms have been ordered.

In late 2015, SGAA became SWAC affiliated, allowing our teams to play other recreational teams in North Carolina at the season’s end for some sports. (See All-star Program in the Handouts section) SWAC currently offers tournaments for soccer, baseball, softball, basketball, and football and may add volleyball. As with any partnership, there are some SGAA rules that do not specifically match SWAC rules; however, most rules are very similar. We began a full partnership with SWAC in 2016.

Kid pitch leagues in baseball may partner with a neighboring organization.

Girls who were six years old between Jan. 1st and April 30th may choose to play baseball or softball in spring.

Players who will move up to a new league the following spring are encouraged to play in that league in the fall. Parents may choose either league for their child in the fall, provided there are enough children in the league.

Schedule: Kid-pitch leagues (ages 9 and older) will play most games Monday through Friday nights, allowing many players to also play in other weekend leagues. Younger kids may play 1-2 games during the week and 1 game on Saturdays. Weeknight games begin at 6 pm with Saturday games beginning at 9 am.

Uniforms: SGAA provides a tee shirt and hat for each baseball player and provides a V-neck tee shirt and socks for each softball player. Once teams are drafted, pants colors will be decided by the parents and/or coaches.

Game Locations: Games are played at the field behind First Baptist Church in Butner, the Corner Field in Butner, and Butner Athletic Park. In the unlikely event of extremely wet conditions for a prolonged period of time, make up games could take place at GAP fields in Oxford.

Schedule: Weeknight games begin at 6 pm; Saturday games begin at 9 am. Practices are extremely limited once games begin.

Game Locations: Soldiers Memorial Sports Arena (416 24th Street in Butner)

Uniforms: SGAA provides a jersey or tee shirt for each player. Kids 6 and younger receive tee shirts. Older boys receive tank type jerseys. Girls' leagues receive V-neck shirts.

Schedule: Most games are played on Tuesday and Thursday nights, but could be scheduled any night Monday through Thursday. Games begin at 6 pm on weeknights.

Uniforms: SGAA provides a tee shirt for each player. Once teams are drafted, pants colors, socks, etc. will be decided upon by the parents and/or coaches.

Schedule: Practices start in early August for 2-3 nights per week, usually Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday beginning at 6 pm. There are normally two cheer squads. The 6-8 year olds cheer for the Mini-Mites game and for the first half of the Mighty-Mite game. The 9-12 year olds cheer for the second half of the Mighty-Mite game and for the Pee Wee game. Teams that qualify for the Super Bowl could play as late as November. Most regular season games begin at 4 pm on Saturdays.

* New in 2015 - Uniforms were custom ordered for each cheerleader who kept the uniform. Because uniforms must arrive before the first game, cheerleaders must be signed up and paid by Aug. 1.

Schedule: All leagues have a maximum number of players and players are only accepted until league maximums are reached or until it is no longer practical to add players. Practices are scheduled for at least 3 days per week, rain or shine. They typically take place on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday from 6-8 pm at Battle Roberts Field in Creedmoor. Most games are played on Saturdays beginning at 4 pm for the youngest league; other leagues follow. Teams that qualify for the Super Bowl could play as late as November.

Game Locations: Games could take place in any of the following counties: Granville, Durham, Franklin, Johnson, and Wake. Schedules can be found at: <http://www.ewfl-football.com/>

Uniforms: SGAA provides helmet, jersey, pants (with butt-pads), shoulder pads, and one mouthpiece. At the season's end, \$30 will be reimbursed to each player when helmet, pants, and shoulder pads are returned. Players keep their jerseys.

Other Information: Teams carry up to 30-35 players per age group. SGAA is affiliated with East Wake league. <http://www.ewfl-football.com/> Gate fees are charged for families of cheerleaders and football players. 2016 fees were \$5 for adults and \$2 for school age kids.
